- 4. Team list can be forwarded later, but we would appreciate it very much if you could provide us with it before Wednesday, 31 July 2013 (definitive Team list to be provided and confirmed with the scorers before the Team's first game, as per Erewhon Cup Rules)

6. Refund:

Any team that withdraws from the competition prior to Wednesday, 17 July 2013 shall be entitled to a refund in full. Any team that withdraws from the competition after Wednesday, 17 July 2013 shall not be eligible for a refund, and that team shall be struck from the draw with all scheduled opponents receiving full game points. Alternative opponents shall be invited to play those games instead, however these games will be considered 'social' games.

Should the tournament or part of it be cancelled by Tekapo Springs, operator of the Ice rink, due to bad weather, ice conditions, we will be able to offer a refund for games not played, Semi -Finals or Final game not incl.

- 7. Erewhon Cup 2013 will be limited to a maximum of 10 teams. If more than 10 teams register for the competition then teams will be accepted on a first-in-first-served basis, however the organizing committee retains discretion to select teams as required to ensure all SIHL clubs are represented.
- 8. Teams shall be split into 2 pools, with each pool seeded at the discretion of the organizing committee. Each team shall play 3 pool games (which may include up to one game against a team from the alternative pool if required to balance games), and this shall determine final pool ranking. Semi-finals games shall be played between the two top teams in each pool (1st of Pool A plays 2nd of Pool B, and in reverse), with a final game played between the winners of the semi's.
- 9. Each team shall be required to perform duty tasks for up to two games, including on-ice officials, score bench and goal judges.
- 10. EREWHON CUP RULES as per updated version 14 May 2012 will apply.

11. FAIR PLAY AWARD & PRIZE:

In the spirit of the EREWHON CUP the organizing Committee will offer the FAIR PLAY AWARD & Prize to the Team with the least Penalties <u>and</u> which has no more than 3 NZIH League Players <u>and</u> which shows the most fair play attitude.

SOUTHERN ICE HOCKEY LEAGUE

EREWHON CUP RULES

- 1/ Each game shall consist of 3 periods of 15 minutes running time. The breaks between periods shall be no more than 2 minutes long. A 5 minute on ice warm-up shall be allowed for.
- 2/ All games will be played under the current rules of the International Ice Hockey Federation and New Zealand Ice Hockey Federation unless specified in this document. Where the two rules clash, the rules of the New Zealand Ice Hockey Federation shall stand.
- 3/ All Clubs competing must be financial members of the Southern Ice Hockey League and conform to its Constitution.
- 4/ All players shall be financial members of their Club and of the New Zealand Ice Hockey Federation. Any player that has an association by virtue of family still living in the Southern Region, is also eligible to play in the Erewhon Cup, as long as they are also registered to NZIHF. Players under suspension in any NZIHF Region or League are ineligible to play in the Erewhon Cup.
- 5/ No player is to play for more than 1 team in the EREWHON CUP competition.
- 6/ Each team may only dress to play, 10 players and 1 goalie for each game. Players may be changed from game to game. Team lists to be limited to a maximum of 15 players plus 2 goalies. Team lists to be provided to the scorers before the Teams first game.
- 7/ On-ice officials shall consist of one referee and two linesmen. At least two people shall be available as timekeepers/ scorers. Two goal judges shall be on duty.
- 8/ In the spirit of the history of the EREWHON CUP the competition shall be played on, in priority order...
 - 1. Natural outdoor ice
 - 2. Artificial outdoor ice
 - 3. Indoor ice.

The decision on when to change from outdoor ice to artificial ice, or to indoor ice must be made at least 5 days before the tournament start. The Erewhon Cup must be played in the SIHL Region only.

- 9/ The ice surface shall be kept in a groomed condition. Every endeavour should be made by the organisers to make the game as fast and as attractive to players and spectators as possible.
- 10/ The ice surface should be clearly marked in accordance with IIHF rules, and maintained by the organisers.

- 11/ Disputes shall be resolved as per section 24 of the SIHL Constitution.
- 12/ The EREWHON CUP format shall always include pool play, followed by semifinals and a final. Each team shall play at least two games in pool play. The Organisers shall seed teams to ensure more even competition.
- 13/ Each team shall receive 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw in pool play.
- 14/ In the case of a semi-final or final that is tied at the end of regulation, the tie shall be resolved via IIHF rule 421.
- 15/ All of the pool play games to be mid-ice contact only. If the semi-finals and final are played on a rink with high boards full contact shall be permitted, otherwise midice contact only will be played.
