CAMP STRUCTURE

The camp will involve on ice sessions for four hours a day. These sessions will focus on the skills of hockey – skating, passing, shooting, body checking, with small area and full ice games.

One of the three coaches is a goalie coach, and goalies will receive full on and off-ice training as part of the programme.

Each day will include off-ice skills development, fitness work, games sessions as well as classroom instruction and video.
