# About the Dunedin Ice Hockey Association:

The club has eight different grades: KiwiHockey (under 10 years), PeeWees (under 13 years), Midgets (13 – 16 years), Juniors (under 19 years), Senior non-contact (over 16 years), Open (19 years and over, with contact), Women (all ages), Oldtimers (over 35), and Beginners (all ages), with a total of about 150 – 200 players.

The DIHA operates out of the Dunedin Ice Stadium, which includes an olympic sized ice hockey rink. The facility accommodates for ice hockey, curling, figure skating, speed skating and public skating.

- Coaching education and Certification proof (5 years of ice hockey coaching experience preferred)
- Playing experience

- Eligible to work in New Zealand for the season.

- Running a coaching program for Kiwihockey and adult players which develops individual and team skills
- Planning, organizing, and conducting practice sessions for all grades (approx 6 hours per week, plus office preparation).
- Running a programme to develop amateur coaching skills
- Adjusting coaching techniques based on the strengths and weaknesses of athletes.
- Reporting to the President of the DIHA on an agreed-upon basis
