Training on the 26th will be 12 minutes on each sheet, rotating from A to B to C to D to E

The first named team has the first pre-game practice session. With the exception for the Women, where the teams will toss a coin to decide first and second practice in the first game and also on 29 April (ita vs sui) team (sui) has the first practice. The exception for the Men, is their 2nd game, where they will toss a coin to determine which team has the first pre-game practice. At the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice, one player delivers one stone to the tee at the home end. The team with the better Last Stone Draw (LSD) has the choice of first or second stone in the first end. If the LSDs are the same, a coin toss will determine which team has the choice.

All games are 8 ends, a minimum of 6 ends must be played in all games.

First named teams in each draw play the stones with the dark coloured handles, and wear dark coloured upper playing garments.
